



2020 Scholarship Application

PURPOSE

The purpose of the Malheur Federal Credit Union scholarship program is to award one \$500, one \$300, and one \$200 scholarship to Malheur Federal Credit Union members to aid them in their pursuit of higher education. Scholarships are a single monetary reward to be applied to the cost of tuition, books, and/or lab fees (if applicable).

ELIGIBILITY

- Must be a member of Malheur Federal Credit Union with an account in your name.
- Must be a graduating high school senior and plan to attend an accredited college, university or technical school in the United States.
- Must provide verification of acceptance to school before scholarship funds are disbursed.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

- All required portions of the application must be completed and returned by April 30, 2020.
- A supporting essay must accompany each scholarship application.
- Optional: A supporting letter of recommendation.

ESSAY REQUIREMENTS

- Essay must be no less than one page in length on given topic.
- Essay will be judged based on content, proper use of grammar, spelling and punctuation.

ESSAY TOPIC

Credit unions are not-for-profit financial institutions whose purpose is to serve its community. How can Malheur Federal Credit Union better appeal to and serve its young adult members?

Additional Inquiry (optional): What do you consider to be the most important services offered by a credit union, and why?

BASIS OF SELECTION

Winners will be judged and selected by a committee made up of Malheur Federal Credit Union employees and Board of Directors.

DEADLINE

- Scholarship winners will be notified by Malheur Federal Credit Union no later than May 18.
